Course Description

This course examines the many aspects of music teaching with particular emphasis placed on teaching oboe technique and repertoire.

Objectives

At the conclusion of the course, the student will have a broad understanding of the art of teaching music performance.

Materials:

Students will need their instrument and related materials. Music will be provided by the professor.

Missed class policy:

If a student must miss a lesson, they must contact the professor at least 24 hours in advance if at all possible. Excused absences include absences due to illness or family emergency, or required exam for another course.

Requirements:

Preparedness for and attendance of each class.

Grading:

Students' semester grades will be based entirely on attendance, preparation, and the final project. For each unexcused absence, your final grade will be lowered (A becomes A-, A- becomes B+, etc...) Regular tardiness will also negatively impact your grade – 3 tardies will equal one unexcused absence. If you are ever in question about your current grade, please consult the professor.
